Qualifications: Must be licensed to practice speech-language pathology by the SD Board of Examiners for Speech- Language Pathology and hold at least a master's degree from an accredited institution. SLPs who held a speech-language certificate from SD DOE as of July 1, 2012 must have at least a bachelor's degree in speech pathology.

Supervision: SLP will work under the direct supervision of the NCSEC Director. Performance evaluations will be completed by the director and school district administration.

Duties and Job Responsibilities:

- 1. Participate in speech/language screenings.
- 2. Assist with and conduct appropriate hearing screenings for member districts.
- 3. Conduct appropriate speech/language evaluations for referred children.
- 4. Participate in placement meetings to determine eligibility for special education services.
- 5. Assist with development of IEPs and IFSPs.
- 6. Attend appropriate IEP and IFSP meetings.
- 7. Develop an appropriate schedule which will meet the needs of the students, teachers, and school district.
- 8. Provide speech/language services to eligible students in Least Restrictive Environment.
- 9. Complete and maintain records and reports of each child.
- 10. Work with school district teaching staff and parents of individual cases.
- 11. Transmit paperwork in a timely manner.
- 12. Attend cooperative in-services and abide by cooperative policies and procedures.
- 13. Perform other duties and functions as requested by the Director
